WHAT IS RINGING SOUND IN THE EARS?

It is a symptom and not a specific disease. Tinnitus is very common—10 to 15% of people experience it to some degree. The noise heard by people with tinnitus may be a buzzing, ringing, roaring, whistling, or hissing sound and is often associated with hearing loss.

REASONS OF RINGING SOUND IN THE EARS

Subjective tinnitus is tinnitus only you can hear. This is the most common type of tinnitus. It can be caused by ear problems in your outer, middle or inner ear. It can also be caused by problems with the hearing (auditory) nerves or the part of your brain that interprets nerve signals as sound (auditory pathways).

SYMPTOMS OF RINGING SOUND IN THE EARS

- Ringing.

- Roaring.
- Clicking.
- Hissing.
- Humming.
