

## **WHAT IS DRYNESS OF EYE?**

When the normal amount of tear production decreases or tears evaporate too quickly from the eyes, symptoms of dry eye can develop. Poor quality of tears. ... This condition, called keratoconjunctivitis sicca (KCS), is also referred to as dry eye syndrome.

## **CAUSES DRYNESS OF EYE**

Common causes of decreased tear production include: Aging. Certain medical conditions, including diabetes, rheumatoid arthritis, lupus, scleroderma, Sjogren's syndrome, thyroid disorders and vitamin A deficiency

## **SYMPTOMS DRYNESS OF EYE**

A patient with dry eye syndrome may experience a range of symptoms, including: a stinging or burning sensation, and a feeling of dryness, grittiness, and soreness in the eyes. a feeling like sand in the eye stringy mucus in or around the eyes.
