- Chemical irritants.
- Allergic reaction.
- Injury to the nose.
- Repeated sneezing.
- Picking the nose.
- Cold air.
- Upper respiratory infection.

SYMPTOMS OF NOSE BLEEDING DISORDERS

Taking antihistamines and decongestants for allergies, colds, or sinus problems can also dry out the nasal membranes and cause nosebleeds. Frequent nose blowing is another cause of nosebleeds. Other common causes of nosebleeds include: foreign object stuck in the nose.
