

WHAT IS PELLAGRA?

a deficiency disease caused by a lack of nicotinic acid or its precursor tryptophan in the diet. It is characterized by dermatitis, diarrhoea, and mental disturbance, and is often linked to over-dependence on maize as a staple food.

REASONS OF PELLAGRA

Pellagra is a disease caused by a lack of the vitamin niacin (vitamin B₃). Symptoms include inflamed skin, diarrhea, dementia, and sores in the mouth. ... There are two main types of pellagra, primary and secondary. Primary pellagra is due to a diet that does not contain enough niacin and tryptophan.

SYMPTOMS OF PELLAGRA

- Delusions or mental confusion.
- Diarrhea.
- Nausea (sometimes)
- Inflamed mucous membrane.
- Scaly skin sores.
