WHAT IS PYORRHOEA?



A serious gum infection that damages gums and can destroy the jawbone.

SYMPTOMS OF PYORRHEA

- Redness or bleeding of gums while brushing teeth or biting into hard food (e.g. apples)
- Gum swelling that occurs frequently even after professional cleaning/scaling.
- Progressively large gap between the teeth and their outward movement.
- Halitosis or bad breath, and a persistent metallic taste in the mouth.

CAUSE OF PYORRHEA

Gum disease, and its related conditions, is known by many names: Gingivitis, Periodontal Disease, Periodontitis (Pyorrhea). Plaque and tartar are full of bacteria, which can then cause an infection of the gums.
