

WHAT IS VOMITING?



Eject matter from the stomach through the mouth.

TYPES OF VOMITING, INCLUDING:

- Possetting – this is when your baby vomits up small amounts after a feed.
- Reflux – this vomiting is common in babies. ...
- Projectile vomiting – this is when your baby brings up the stomach contents in a forceful way.

CAUSES OF VOMITING

The timing of the nausea or vomiting can indicate the cause. When appearing shortly after a meal, nausea or vomiting may be caused by food poisoning, gastritis (inflammation of the stomach lining), an ulcer, or bulimia. ... However, certain food-borne bacteria, such as salmonella, can take longer to produce symptoms

SYMPTOMS THAT OCCUR WITH NAUSEA AND VOMITING INCLUDE:

- Abdominal pain.
- Diarrhea.
- Fever.
- Lightheadedness.
- Vertigo.
- Rapid pulse.
- Excessive sweating.
- Dry mouth.

NEUROTHERAPY TREATMENT

- If during vomiting only food from upper part of the stomach has come out then stomach acid will be lost. The colour of vomited food will be white.
