WHAT IS RHINITIS?



Rhinitis, also known as coryza, is irritation and inflammation of the mucous membrane inside the nose. Common symptoms are a stuffy nose, runny nose, sneezing, and post-nasal drip. The most common kind of rhinitis is allergic rhinitis, which is usually triggered by airborne allergens such as pollen and dander.

Rhinitis is categorized into three types (although

infectious rhinitis is typically regarded as a separate clinical entity due to its transient nature): (i) infectious rhinitis includes acute and chronic bacterial infections; (ii) nonallergic. (vasomotor) rhinitis includes idiopathic, hormonal, atrophic, occupational.

CAUSES OF RHINITIS

This chemical can cause allergic rhinitis and its symptoms, including a runny nose, sneezing, and itchy eyes. In addition to tree pollen, other common allergens include: grass pollen. dust mites.

- Sneezing.
- A runny nose.
- A stuffy nose.
- An itchy nose.
- Coughing.
- A sore or scratchy throat.
- Itchy eyes.
- Watery eyes.
