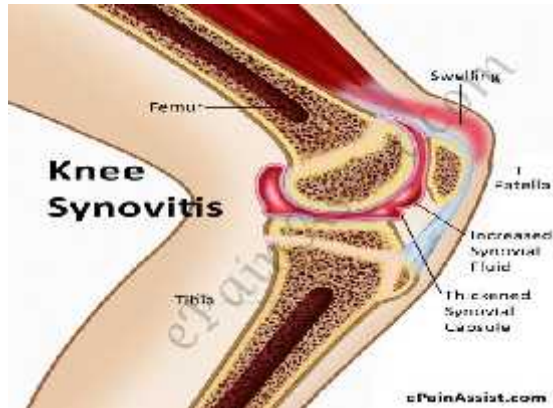


WHAT IS SYNOVITIS OF THE KNEES?



The synovial membrane is the part of the body that lines the inside of certain joints. It lines the joint capsule in the knee, ankle, wrist, elbow, hand, foot, and shoulder. When this membrane gets inflamed, it is called synovitis.

TYPES OF SYNOVITIS OF THE KNEES

Planar, hinge, pivot, condyloid, saddle, and ball-and-socket are all types of synovial joints.

- Planar Joints. Planar joints have bones with articulating surfaces that are flat or slightly curved faces. ...

SYMPTOMS OF SYNOVITIS OF THE KNEE

Synovitis causes joint tenderness or pain, swelling and hard lumps, called nodules. When associated with rheumatoid arthritis, swelling is a better indicator than tenderness.
