

WHAT IS BLADDER DISEASES?

Cystitis - inflammation of the bladder, often from an infection. Urinary incontinence - loss of bladder control. Overactive bladder - a condition in which the bladder squeezes urine out at the wrong time. Interstitial cystitis - a chronic problem that causes bladder pain and frequent, urgent urination. Bladder cancer.

CAUSES OF BLADDER DISEASES

Several different bladder problems can cause pain. The three most common causes of bladder pain are interstitial cystitis, urinary tract infection, and bladder cancer.

SYMPTOMS OF BLADDER DISEASES

- Cystitis - inflammation of the bladder, often from an infection.
- Urinary incontinence - loss of bladder control.
- Overactive bladder - a condition in which the bladder squeezes urine out at the wrong time.
- Interstitial cystitis - a chronic problem that causes bladder pain and frequent, urgent urination.

NEUROTHERAPY TREATMENT

Ñ Bladder may get infected by germs that come up from the urethra. In bladder fistula, urine may leak into rectum.

Ñ In inflammation of bladder (cystitis), bacteria travel up the urethra to the bladder. In men, the prostate gland gets inflamed.
