TYPES OF NEPHRITIS

There are several types of nephritis that can occur in the kidneys. There are several different types of nephritis, including: Acute glomerulonephritis: This form of nephritis can develop suddenly after a severe infection, such as strep throat, hepatitis, or HIV.

CAUSES OF NEPHRITIS

Nephritis is often caused by infections, and toxins, but is most commonly caused by autoimmune disorders that affect the major organs like kidneys. Pyelonephritis is inflammation that results from a urinary tract infection that reaches the renal pelvis of the kidney.

SYMPTOMS OF NEPHRITIS

- Pain in the pelvis.
- Pain or a burning sensation while urinating.
- A frequent need to urinate.
- Cloudy urine.
- Blood or pus in the urine.
- Pain in the kidney area or abdomen.
- Swelling of the body, commonly in the face, legs, and feet.
- Vomiting.
